## **ORDINANCE 96-43** IMC AGRICO COMPANY (FOUR CORNERS MINE DRI #5)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 95-41, TO AMEND THE EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners approved Ordinance 95-41, adopting amendments to the Development Order for IMC Agrico Company (Four Corners Mine #5) which amended Ordinances 91-62 and 92-64, on October 3, 1995; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners and IMC Agrico Company desire to amend the effective date of Ordinance 95-41 in order to facilitate the completion of a land exchange; and

WHEREAS, the proposed change does not unreasonably interfere with the achievement of the objectives of the adopted State Land Development Plan; and

WHEREAS, the proposed change does not materially change the approved Development Order and is necessary only to extend the time to meet the prerequisites necessary for Ordinance 95-41 to become effective; and

WHEREAS, the proposed change is consistent with the State Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the proposed change will be consistent with the Manatee County Comprehensive Plan and the Manatee County Land Development Code; and

WHEREAS, said Board of County Commissioners has considered all of the foregoing and has been advised and informed in the premises.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

1. Section 16. of Manatee County Ordinance 95-41 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

This Ordinance shall take effect upon the Ordinance rezoning the Land Exchange Area\* to permit phosphate mining becoming effective. If said rezoning does not occur before December 31, 1996, this Ordinance shall be null and void and Ordinances 91-62 and 92-64 shall remain in effect.

All other provisions of Development Order Ordinance 95-41 shall remain in full force and effect. In the event there is an inconsistency between the terms of this Ordinance and the Ordinance referred to above, the terms of this Ordinance shall control.
