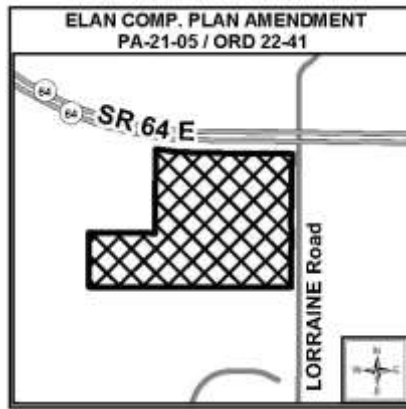

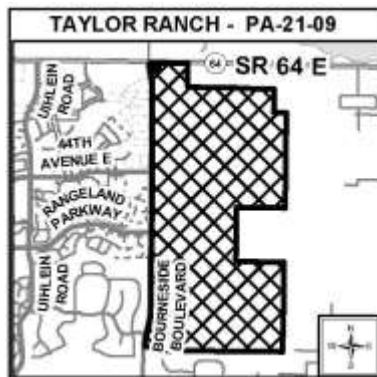

An Ordinance of the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, regarding Comprehensive Planning, amending Manatee County Ordinance No. 89-01, as amended (the Manatee County Comprehensive Plan); providing a purpose and intent; providing findings; providing for a privately-initiated map amendment to the Future Land Use Map of the Future Land Use Element to designate 19.803± acres of specific real property generally located at the southwest corner of the intersection of State Road 64 East and Lorraine Road, and commonly known as 14366, 14410 State Road 64 East, and 2610, 2710 Lorraine Road, Bradenton (Manatee County) from the UF-3 (Urban Fringe - 3 dwelling units/acre) Future Land Use Classification to the RES-9 (Residential – 9 dwelling units/acre) Future Land Use Classification; providing for severability and providing an effective date.

An Ordinance of the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, regarding comprehensive planning, amending Manatee County Ordinance No. 89-01, as amended (the Manatee County Comprehensive Plan); providing a purpose and intent; providing findings; providing for a privately-initiated large scale comprehensive plan map and text amendment to Element 2 – Future Land Use Element of the Manatee County Comprehensive Plan to change the Future Land Use Classification of 2,307.57± acres of a specific real property generally located at the southeast corner of SR 64 East and Bourneside Boulevard, at 18900 SR 64 East, Bradenton, (Manatee County), from AG/R (Agricultural Rural) to the UF-3 (Urban Fringe-3 Dwelling Units Per Acre) Future Land Use Classification; providing for a specific property development condition in the text of the Comprehensive Plan to limit the density maximum potential to 1.95 dwelling units per acre (4,500 units); providing for severability and providing an effective date.



The Public is invited to speak at this hearing, subject to proper rules of conduct. The hearing may be continued from time to time to a date and time certain. The Public may also provide written comments for the Board of County Commissioners to consider.
