## <u>LDA-23-03 –LOCAL DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT / MANATEE LAND INVESTORS, LLC (WATERCOLOR PLACE) - PLN2310-0053</u>

Request for approval of a Local Development Agreement relating to future projects within an area identified as Watercolor Place to establish the terms under which the parties agree that it is beneficial for the owner/developer to construct off-site transportation improvements that will benefit a regionally significant transportation facility, namely the UMRR Widening Project, in order to minimize public costs and create additional roadway capacity in the area of the Project; satisfaction of transportation concurrency requirements; mitigation for transportation impacts of future development projects in the area of the UMRR Widening Project; and eligibility for reimbursement.

Manatee Land Investors, LLC, owner/developer of the 288-acre parcel, generally located at the west side of the intersection of Port Harbour Parkway and Upper Manatee River Road, Bradenton, (Manatee County), commonly known as "Watercolor Place", which represents a portion of the project known as Heritage Harbour, which is currently approved pursuant to Ordinance No. 23-92 (the "DRI Ordinance"), and Ordinance No. PDMU-98-08(G)(R12). The approved development includes a maximum of 1,675 residential units (single-family detached, single-family attached, multi-family and assisted living facility), pursuant to a land use equivalency matrix, and the maximum permitted heights for any building within the Project Site is 5 stories, subject to the standards provided on the approved General Development Plan.
