AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO BUCKHEAD TRAILS II COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT; PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS; SPECIFYING AUTHORITY; SPECIFYING INTENT AND PURPOSE; AMENDING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT PURSUANT TO SECTION 190.046(1), FLORIDA STATUTES, BY ADDING APPROXIMATELY 36.51 ACRES OF LAND; AMENDING SECTION 2-8-82 OF THE MANATEE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES TO DESCRIBE THE AMENDED BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT AS EXPANDED; PROVIDING FOR RELIANCE UPON REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The proposed Buckhead Trails II Community Development District currently contains approximately 409.16 acres and is generally located between I-75 and US Highway 301 and north of Buckeye Road and south of Valroy Road, Manatee County, Florida. The Petitioner proposes to expand the district by 36.51 acres which will increase the area to approximately 445.67 acres. The approximate location of the expansion area is shown on the Location Map attached as Exhibit "A".

All interested parties are invited to appear at this hearing and be heard, subject to theproper rules of conduct. Additionally, any comments filed with the Director of the Planning Department will be considered by the Board of County Commissioners and entered in the record.
