

**RESOLUTION R-18-144**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE 2015/16 and 2017/18 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) ANNUAL ACTION PLANS**

**WHEREAS**, on June 16, 2015, the Board approved Resolution R-15-085, adopting the Community Development Block Grant 2015/16 Annual Action Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 25, 2017, the Board approved Resolution R-17-084, adopting the Community Development Block Grant 2017/18 Annual Action Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolutions R-15-085 and R-17-084 approved specific CDBG, HOME, and ESG activities; and

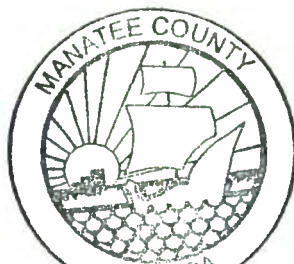
**WHEREAS**, this substantial amendment reallocates a portion of CDBG and HOME funding from the 2015/16 and 2017/18 Action Plans; and

**WHEREAS**, the process for amending a Consolidated Plan and/or Annual Action Plan is outlined in Manatee County's Citizen Participation Plan and each of those steps have been followed in this process, to include a 30-day public comment period.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners that:

1. Resolution R-18-144 is hereby adopted to provide for an amendment to the 2015/16 and 2017/18 Annual Action Plans as attached hereto.
2. The County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to approve and execute subrecipient funding agreements, amendments, and associated standard Land Use and Deed Restriction Agreements, and, authorize payments up to the maximum allowable funding for Federal CDBG, ESG, and HOME program activities as approved and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners in Manatee County's Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plans.

Notice of Proposed Substantial Amendment  
2015/16, and 2017/18 Annual Action Plans Activities**

In accordance with its Citizen Participation Plan and US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations, Manatee County is notifying the public of proposed changes to activities found in the 2015/16 and 2017/18 Annual Action Plans. Affected activities are funded with Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) funds.

The proposed substantial amendment will:

1. Decrease the 15/16 HOME CHDO Set-Aside activity by \$84,438.90 (15% set-aside requirement met); and
2. Increase the 15/16 HOME Manatee County Rehabilitation/Reconstruction activity by \$84,438.90.
3. Cancel the 17/18 CDBG Manatee County Public Works Sunny Lakes Edge Mill and Resurfacing activity for \$121,118.00; and
4. Increase the 17/18 CDBG Manatee County Public Works Overstreet Park/Tangerine Terrace Edge Mill and Resurfacing activity by \$80,000.00; and
5. Increase the 17/18 CDBG Manatee County Public Works Orange Ridge Edge Mill and Resurfacing activity by \$41,118.00.

RESOLUTION B-18-109  
AMENDING THE ANNUAL BUDGET  
FOR MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA  
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018

**WHEREAS,** Florida Statutes 129.06, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to amend its budget for the current fiscal year as follows:

- a) Appropriations for expenditures in any fund may be decreased and other appropriations in the same fund correspondingly increased, provided the total appropriations of the fund are not changed.
- b) Appropriations from reserves may be made to increase the appropriation for any particular expense in the same fund, or to create an appropriation in the fund for any lawful purpose.
- c) Unanticipated revenues, including increased receipts for enterprise or proprietary funds, may be appropriated for their intended purpose, and may be transferred between funds to properly account for the unanticipated revenue.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida that the 2017-2018 budget is hereby amended in accordance with FS 129.06 as described on the attached summary and specified in the budget adjustment batch files which are listed below:

Department: REDEVELOPMENT & ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY  
Fund: CDBG GRANT FUND  
Fund: HOME FUND  
Description: Transfers \$84,439 from HOME 15/16 CHDO to HOME 15/16 homeowner rehabilitation/reconstruction for home construction and rehabilitation. Deappropriates \$121,118 from the CDBG 17/18 Sunny Lakes Resurfacing project; appropriates \$80,000 to the CDBG 17/18 Overstreet Park Resurfacing project and \$41,118 to the CDBG 17/18 Orange Ridge Edge Mill Resurfacing project. Construction bids for all three projects came in higher than anticipated so the Sunny Lakes project is being cancelled, and funding is transferred to the remaining two resurfacing projects. Resolution R-18-144 is being presented to the Board of County Commissioners with this budget amendment.

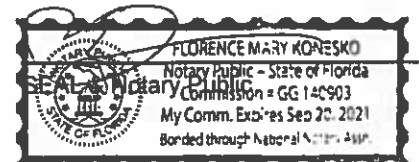
